She has served as a church choir director in Waukegan and Libertyville. Ms. Huber first worked with preschoolers at the Circle Center Preschool at Christ Community Church. She taught Kindermusik from 1995 to 2000 and was certified in the Beginnings, Growings and Young Child curricula, and also taught preschool music classes at the Jack Benny Center for the Arts. ## Open up the world of music for your child!

### Why music?

A ten-year study tracking more than 25,000 students shows that music-making improves test scores. Regardless of socioeconomic background, music-making students get higher marks in standardized tests than those who had no music involvement. The test scores studied were not only standardized tests, such as the SAT, but also in reading proficiency exams. *Source: Dr. James Catterall, UCLA, 1997*
